Quanset Cover 01550

September Garden

Not all my experiments are timely. It was September when I got around to experimenting with overlaying a garden with pavers to reduce surface evaporation.

Nonetheless, I planted the area with some leftover bedding flowers and one freshly sprouted seedling of butternut

squash. To be honest, I felt kind of guilty planting this hopeful little plant in a nurturing environment, when the season would never give it enough time to mature. But it forgave me.

It somehow managed to produce well before the first frost, so I figure the least I could do would be to reward it with a modicum of protection.

I had some 3' wide field fence on hand, so I cut it into three 10' lengths and wove #9 galvanized wire into both of their edges to give the pieces a little strength. I then wired the edges together to form a 9' long quanset structure.
